

Nevada In-State Office Requirement:

Pursuant to NRS 675.090, a company can only apply for a license outside this State if the company or an affiliate holds and Installment Loan License for a location in this State. Be advised that any location that wishes to conduct lending activities to people in Nevada or from a location in Nevada must apply for a license.

The Nevada location cannot be a virtual office. It must meet the following requirements:

- Be open to the public at a minimum during normal business hours, Monday through Friday,
- Be staffed by at least one employee of the company that is trained and knowledgeable on the products and services offered by the company,
- The office must not be located within the office space of any other company, and
- The office must have adequate signage to allow customs and FID examiners the ability to locate the office.

I understand that in order to obtain and maintain a license as an Installment Loan Company in Nevada, the application must meet the above requirements. Failure to maintain the Nevada office as required will result in denial, suspension or revocation of the license.
