## Student Loan Servicers / Lenders Small Business Impact Questionnaire (Response Requested by September 11, 2023)

The Nevada Financial Institutions Division (NFID) is planning to promulgate regulations in support of Assembly Bill 332 (AB332) governing Student Loan Servicers under a new chapter of Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and Private Education Lenders under NRS Chapter 675. The first step is for NFID to receive input from small businesses regarding the adverse and beneficial impacts the proposed regulations may have on those small businesses. NFID will then hold a workshop(s) in the near future to continue the rulemaking process.

- 1. Establish framework to license and regulate student loan servicers.
- 2. Establish fees.
- 3. Clarify the applicability of certain statutory provisions.
- 4. Update provisions of NAC 675.
- 5. Provide other matters properly relating to the regulation of AB332.

- 2. Consider methods to reduce the impact of the proposed regulations; and
- 3. Prepare a small impact statement and make copies of the statement available to the public at the workshop conducted and the public hearing held pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 233B.061.
